Veolia owns, operates and maintains the Red Lion integrated on-site acid regeneration plant to support the adjacent PBF Delaware City Refinery's sulfuric acid regeneration needs, which are critical to the refinery's operations. Red Lion also provides sulfur management services by recovering part of the refinery's acid gas production as sulfuric acid. This facility was commissioned in 2005.
