year's event will be held at the Linfield National Golf Club and promises to build on the fun and networking we had at last year's event. Please visit our web site for details on these two events.

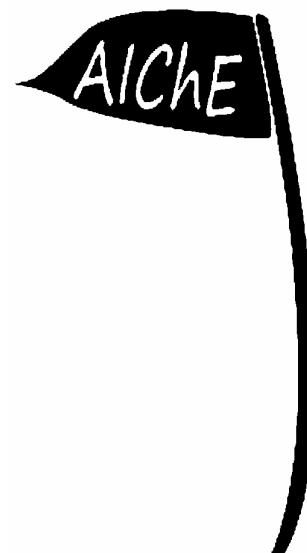
